

**Articulation Agreement  
Between Glenville State College and Pierpont Community and Technical College**

**I. PURPOSE**

These guidelines are designed to facilitate and coordinate the articulation transfer processes and procedures, enhance advising, and promote the acceptance of equivalent courses/credits between Glenville State College and Pierpont Community and Technical College allowing for an efficient and effective transition from an Associate degree to a Bachelor degree.

**II. ELEMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT**

**A. ADMISSION PRACTICES**

1. Glenville State College accepts applications from students who wish to transfer directly from the Pierpont Community and Technical College Associate of Applied Science program to the Glenville State College Bachelor of Applied Science program.
2. Guaranteed admission to Glenville State College is provided for students who earn an Associate of Applied Science degree from Pierpont Community and Technical College with a cumulative GPA of no less than 2.0.
3. Glenville State College will give Pierpont Community and Technical College graduates a one time, one semester \$500 scholarship to be applied to the first full time semester at Glenville State College.

**B. ACCEPTANCE AND APPLICATION OF CREDITS**

1. Transcripts of students completing an AAS at Pierpont Community and Technical College will be reviewed by Glenville State College to determine which of the general education requirements are met.
2. Transferring Pierpont Community and Technical College students must meet all listed course and GPA requirements, as outlined by the approved Glenville State College articulation pathway, for acceptance into their intended program. The Glenville State College Math Department Assessment may be required for certain major specific courses, e.g. College Algebra or Chemistry. The placement examination will only be administered to transferring students who are not transferring credit for appropriate math pre-requisites and who do not present other placement scores provided for by HEPC Series 21 §133-21-4 or listed in the course prerequisites. Further information is included in the advising sheets specific to those majors.
3. Grades earned at Pierpont will be transferred and will be calculated in the overall GPA.
4. Glenville State College will evaluate courses/credits earned through Advanced Placement (AP), EDGE credit, and College-Level Examination Program (CLEP). Glenville State College also reserves the right to evaluate courses/credits earned at non-TES (Transfer Equivalency System) institutions. Credit is not guaranteed for these sources and will be reviewed for credit consistent with Glenville State College standards and pre-established course equivalencies.



5. Glenville State College will maintain course equivalency information of its courses and make this information readily available to the Registrar's Office at Pierpont Community and Technical College as needed.
6. All credits and grades accepted as transfer credit will be used in the calculation of the cumulative grade point average and total attempted/earned credits. Transfer credits from community colleges are limited to seventy-two hours of lower-division courses. Students articulating from Pierpont Community and Technical College will be required to complete their final 30 credit hours at Glenville State College (in residence).
7. Prescribed curricula aligning the transfer of courses from Pierpont Community and Technical College to Glenville State College are outlined in this articulation agreement for the following degrees: *AAS Business Management Degree (Pierpont CTC) leading to BSBA with a Concentration in Management Degree (GSC)*, *AAS Medical Laboratory Technology Degree (Pierpont CTC) leading to BAS Degree (GSC)*, *AAS Physical Therapist Assistant Degree (Pierpont CTC) leading to BS in Health and Human Performance with a Concentration in Exercise Science Degree (GSC)*, *AAS Medical Laboratory Technology Degree (Pierpont CTC) leading to BSBA with a Concentration in Management Degree (GSC)*, *AA Criminal Justice Degree (Pierpont CTC) leading to BS in Criminal Justice with a Concentration in Administration of Justice Degree (GSC)*, *AAS Health Sciences Degree (Pierpont CTC) leading to BSBA with a Concentration in Management Degree (GSC)*.


**C. UPDATE/REPORT/RELATIONSHIP**

Glenville State College and Pierpont Community and Technical College agree to review the agreement and relevant transfer course equivalencies annually. Pierpont Community and Technical College will designate an individual to serve as liaison for the purposes of monitoring this agreement.

**D. AMENDMENTS AND TERM OF EFFECT**

This master agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either party upon written notice to the other party of an intention to terminate. Such notice will be effective only if given 30 days prior to the intended date of termination. In the event that this agreement is terminated, the terms of the agreement contained herein will remain in effect for the Pierpont Community and Technical College students accepted at Glenville State College prior to the date of termination notice.
