****Students are not required to take MTH 1207 (MATH 121 WVU) and MTH 1212 (MATH 126 WVU) unless they do not place directly into MTH 1285 at Pierpont. WVU only requires students to MATH 150 or MATH 155 to satisfy the major requirement. This will need to be completed prior to the first semester at WVU.**

To be admitted to the John Chambers College of Business and Economics fields, students must have an overall GPA of 2.25. Students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- ACC 2202 & 2215
- ECO 2201 & 2202
- ENG 1104 & 1108
- MTH 1212 & MATH 150 (WVU)
- BUSN 1102
- OFAD 1150

Students completing this proposed pathway may choose to major within one of the following Chambers College of Business and Economics fields:

Accounting; Economics; Entrepreneurship and Innovation; Finance; General Business; Global Supply Chain Management; Hospitality & Tourism; Integrated Marketing Communication; Management; Management Information Systems; Marketing; or Organizational Leadership.

The following course require ACCT 202:

- Accounting
- Finance
- Global Supply Chain Management
- Management

Depending upon the student's choice of major, additional criteria for admissions must also be met:

- Accounting: A grade of B or higher in ACCT 201 & 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Economics: One B or higher, and one C or higher in ECON 201 and 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Finance: A grade of B or higher in ECON 201 & 202; A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Global Supply Chain Management: A minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Entrepreneurship and Innovation: minimum grade of D- in MATH 150.
- Management: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150. A grade of D- in MATH 155.
- Management Information System: minimum grade of B- in MATH 150.
- Marketing: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.
- Organizational Leadership: minimum grade of C- in MATH 150.

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
