Students are encouraged to take them at the indicated time, but as they are not required by the AAS program, they can be taken at any point prior to the student's intended semester of beginning the HTOR program at WVU. Students who deviate from the suggested plan of study should consult their Academic Advisor to ensure they are taking all required courses prior to transferring to WVU.

Courses listed with "No Credit" are required as part of the AAS curriculum but are not accepted by West Virginia University due to their technical nature.

Students transferring into the Hospitality and Tourism Management program at WVU must possess an overall GPA of 2.0 and have completed the following prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

• OFAD 1150; ECON 2201 & 2202 or ECON 210 & 202 (WVU); MTH 1212 & MATH 150 (WVU); ENG 1104 & 1108; ACCT 201 & 202 (WVU); and STAT 211/ECON 225 (WVU)

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.

Students who have questions regarding this articulation agreement or the transferability of coursework may contact the WVU Office of the University Registrar. All other questions should be directed to the WVU Office of Admissions.
