Students transferring into the Hospitality and Tourism Management program at WVU must possess an overall GPA of 2.0 and have completed the following prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

 OFAD 1150; ECON 2201 & 2202 or ECON 210 & 202 (WVU); MTH 1212 & MATH 150 (WVU); ENG 1104 & 1108; ACCT 2201; and STAT 211/ECON 225 (WVU)

Students transferring to West Virginia University with an Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree will have satisfied the General Education Foundation requirements at WVU.
