

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

between

Pierpont Community & Technical College and SUNY Polytechnic Institute

This agreement provides graduates of Pierpont Community & Technical College's Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree program with transfer paths to the Bachelor of Science (B.P.S.) degrees at the State University of New York Polytechnic Institute (SUNY Poly). Degree path is as follows: **A.A.S. degree Health Information Technology to the B.P.S. degree in Health Information Management.**

Objectives of the Agreement:

1. To guarantee admission of transfer students from Pierpont Community & Technical College who satisfy the criteria described in this agreement.
2. To attract qualified students to Pierpont Community & Technical College and SUNY Poly.
3. To provide specific information for transfer students who wish to pursue a baccalaureate degree.
4. To encourage academic coordination between Pierpont Community & Technical College and SUNY Poly.


Agreement:

1. SUNY Poly agrees to accept Pierpont Community & Technical College graduates from the A.A.S. degree stated above, with a minimum 2.50 GPA, and who meet the admissions criteria at their term of transfer for the B.P.S. degree indicated at SUNY Poly.
2. Students who follow the Advisement Plan attached to this agreement will receive the agreed upon hours of transfer credit towards the hours required for the B.P.S. degree.
3. Students will maximize transfer credit by following the attached Advisement Plan. Any deviation from the suggested electives outlined in the plans may affect transfer credits and time to B.P.S. degree completion.
4. Both Pierpont Community & Technical College and SUNY Poly agree to encourage qualified students to participate by providing information and assistance to prospective transfer students. Pierpont Community & Technical College will list the agreement on its website, and make information available to advisors and students.
5. Both colleges may publicize the articulation in the appropriate college publications, bulletins and college websites.
6. The terms of the articulation will remain in effect until March 2024 or amended by mutual agreement; The Advisement Plan will be reviewed annually and appropriate curriculum changes made do not affect the terms of this agreement. This agreement is effective upon signature.


